Programme Note CULTURE UNSTAINED

RBC's sponsorship of the arts is dwarfed by its \$290 billion investments in fossil fuels since the Paris Agreement, making it one of the biggest funders of climate destruction in the world, 12.8% of the bank's total holdings are in companies complicit in genocide and apartheid.

RBC holds over \$37 billion worth of investments in companies complicit in war crimes, including weapons manufacturers arming Israel in the ongoing genocide against the Palestinian people. Just this year, RBC has more than doubled its stake in Boeing, which produces Israel's "weapon of choice".

RBC is a major funder of Palantir and other producers of Al-based combatant policing systems targeting both Palestinians and First Nations communities as they peacefully defend their lands from pipelines, such as the RBC-funded Coastal Gaslink and TMX projects which violate Indigenous consent on unceded territory.

Yet The Old Vic continues to paint RBC in a positive light in its communications – this is what sponsorship money buys. RBC's relationship as a 'Principal Partner' to The Old Vic is a cynical branding exercise which is a transaction, not a donation.

If The Old Vic is serious about its 'social mission', it will join the long list of cultural institutions which have liberated themselves from fossil fuel funding.
