

Reputational: There are increasing protests at Barclays sponsorship of Sadler's Wells and artists withdrawing from the programme. Org mit: Being open to conversations with artists, staff and organisations about why they accept the sponsorship. ACE mit: Email from Section 40.2 to explain Cause4 research and offer to meet. Meeting with

Financial: The organisation's Business case identified a need for a revenue investment of £4m per annum, both for the extension to NPO funding in 26/27 and for future NPO funding being amalgamated into the existing grant. Org mit: The organisation continues to make the case for the project. ACE mit: Ongoing monitoring.

Financial: SW has identified essential repairs and renewals for its Islington building. There is a risk that SW Foundation resources might be unequal to the repairs programme. Org mit: The exec team are working with the Foundation to prioritise rebuilding of reserves. ACE mit: RM will monitor progress and highlight any other funding opportunities.
