1.0 Kings College London / University College London Progress Update

1.1 Project 'Roll-Out'

- Schools will be completing post-intervention surveys this term

1.2 Teacher Conference and Resources

- A date has been set for the teacher conference in York (12th and 13th October). Work on planning this has begun.
- Work continues on putting together the teacher resources material as pack for teachers to use (individually and as part of PD)

1.3 Publications and Dissemination

- Corrections to articles under review (x3) have also been underway
- Further publications in development
- Team have talked at various events including CLSG Founder Day
- Papers are currently being prepared for presentation at forthcoming conferences e.g. Ecsite (June), ESERA (August)

1.4 Adult Science Capital Work

- This continues - both waves of the instrument development work and testing have been completed. Work on the analyses is now underway.
